

Churches that have signed the commitment forms met on June 19th. No new progress has been completed. Still only 8 churches are on board. It was suggested that one person from each church sign up as a contact person. I signed up as the contact for Messiah. I felt that since Family Promise fell under the Outreach Team it should be my responsibility. If anyone else would like to volunteer that would be fine. It was also suggested that each church make regular announcements during services regarding Family Promise to keep the congregation updated on the progress of Family Promise.
